Service Opportunities

1. Head Coaches –oversee general operations; communicate with other coaches and team members, along with children and parents about upcoming events and activities; actively participate during WOL dub; keep a record of attendance, decisions for Christ and other significant events for an annual report.
2. Gopher Buddy and Olympian Coaches-plan out the lessons for the year and distribute the materials to each appropriate coach; encourage the coaches and team members by assisting them when needed and thanking them for their commitment.
3. Worship Coaches-schedule capable team members to lead worship and provided the materials necessary for worship.
4. Worship Team Member-dynamic, and able to project; lead children in worship; say pledges and books of the Bible with the children, along with opening in prayer.
5. Bible Review Coaches-schedule capable team members to lead the Bible Review Game and provide them with instructions and materials needed for the games.
6. Bible Review Team Member-dynamic, lead the children in a Bible review game, (tic-tac-toe, lego, etc.)
7. Bible Challenge Coaches-schedule capable team members to teach; communicate with drama coach as to when dramas are needed and supply them with the scripts.
8. Bible Challenge Team Member-dynamic, lots of energy; able to keep children engage in the lesson.
9. Drama Coaches-schedule capable team members for skits and puppet shows and provide them with the necessary scripts and props.
10. Drama Team Members-dynamic, lots of energy, able to project, enjoys acting.
11. Small Group Coaches-divide the children into groups of 4-6 children according to their age and schedule capable small group leaders for each group and guide them on how to conduct their small group.
12. Small Group Team Member-Take prayer request and pray with the children in your group; go over review questions, and help children with memory verses.
13. Big-O-Vent Coaches-schedule capable team members to lead the children in a game-1-2 leaders per age group pre-k-k, 1st-2nd grade, and 3rd-5th grade; provide the team members with the necessary supplies in order to play the game.
14. Big-O-Vent Team Members-dynamic, fun, full of energy and loud, lead children in game time.
15. Recording and Awards Coaches-schedule team members to check the children when they arrive each week; provide team members with what is necessary to do their job, bucks, sticker, and records sheets; keep a record of attendance, salvations, service projects, special events, adult accountability sheets; send reports to area missionary; oversee Bible Memory Quizzes.
16. Records Team Members-check children's Quiet Time Journals, listen to verses, and encourage children.
17. Party and Special Event Coaches-plan Christmas story and end of year party, along with fascar and any other special events; communicate with Head Coaches about budget.
18. Christian Service Coaches-plan and organize service projects monthly/bi-monthly (Operation Christmas Child, manna project, etc.); communicate with team members, parents, and children about the projects.
